## STUDENTS ARE STARTING BACK TO SCHOOL— Let's Think Safety---

Just a reminder to please watch out for the school students. Please take caution around school area's traveling on the roads and school bus stops. Remember flashing yellow lights on a school bus means you must slow down, prepare to stop and not to attempt to pass the bus. Oncoming cars must drop their speed to 20 miles per hour or less in preparation to stop for the red lights. When the red lights are flashing and the stop arm is out, every Motorists must stop when they are behind a bus, meeting the bus or approaching an intersection where a bus is stopped. Motorists following or traveling alongside a school bus must also stop until the red lights have stopped flashing, the stop arm is withdrawn, and all children have reached safety.

If physical barriers such as grassy medians, guide rails or concrete median barriers separate oncoming traffic from the bus, motorists in the opposing lanes may proceed without stopping.

These big yellow buses are hauling our most precious cargo (Our Children). So, give yourself a little extra time on your travels and find patience's for the big yellow bus and its passengers.

We want everyone to reach their destination safely.

Most bus companies now have equipped their buses with camera's that can get the make of your car and license number for an easy identification for any traffic violations.

PA state law for violation with a bus is---  
60 days suspension of driver's license  
5 points on your driving record  
\$250.00 Fine
